<p>An imaginary journey through the woods where participants are invited to use the existing design or to create their own characters to make a personal project. The fun of this quilt is the multilayered technique of wonky cuts as well as a quilt-as-you-go method, raw edge applique and just a bit of imagination.</p> 	<p>Looking for a project to practice letting fabric do the work? This is the quilt! Colour makes us happy. Colour Works is the opportunity to combine contemporary fabrics with bright bold designs with plain and striped fabrics. Here is an exercise using vibrant polychromatic prints that can be added to your stash of batiks or hand dyed fabrics.</p> 	<p>Generally participants in the class select one of the many patterns to make or to use as a starting point for their own designs. This workshop is rather open ended, as there are several options for participants to choose from for the class. We will start with a discussion about the wedges and how to use them as well as a conversation about selecting fabric.</p>

Constructed in strips you'll learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How to make fabric • Free-form curved cutting and piecing • Foundation piecing • *Wonky" flying geese • Curved piecing • *"Wonky" zig zags • *Design your own strip with a technique of your choice 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have fun piecing traditional quilt blocks in a non-traditional manner. • Bring lots of fabric pieces – fat quarter or smaller and let your hair down creating your own version of lots of fun blocks. • FREE-FORM CUTTING will be the order of the day and you'll have lots of blocks to combine into a quirky sampler or use as you please.   	<p>Great scrap buster</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quilt measures 58" square but you can make it bigger by adding more borders. • Star blocks are 20" square. • Stars are foundation pieced using "strings" of fabric so it's a good scrap buster. • Surround your four large centre blocks with some funky fabric borders and you got a great scrap quilt. • Pattern includes instructions and an original foundation for your to keep and copy.

<p>This workshop will teach you several bias appliqué techniques to create simple and stunning designs. Working with several tools, you'll be shown how easy it is to make your own bias strips and prepare them for an endless range of design possibilities. Although this is a techniques based workshop, you may choose to make blocks for cushions, tote bag, table runner or make a great start on a large quilt project.</p> 	<p>Throw the rules out the window, there's no quilting police in this class. This could easily be the most fun you've ever had cutting and sewing a quilt together. If you've wanted to try improvisational cutting and piecing, here is your opportunity. With some guidance on how to cut without rulers, and a bit of practice, you will be piecing quilt tops together in a day. You will be shown a few assembly tricks that will guarantee a perfectly flat quilt top. You'll be able to create your own quilt recipe to make unique 'one of a kind' quilts. You should be able to complete a small quilt top in this class.</p> 	<p>This is a great project to develop your improvised cutting and piecing skills. Here you will learn how to free cut curves and piece without pins. There are a few tricks to learn so the quilt top remains flat. You have the added bonus of learning an easy quilt as you go technique to finish the project. This method of construction may have you rethinking your approach to future projects and will introduce you to some very liberating ideas and techniques.</p>

Choose bold fabrics, contemporary, reproduction or simply fun! • In this class we will cover block construction and precision piecing and a variety of layouts. • Pattern is included in the class fee. 	<p style="text-align: center;">Karen Styles Ambrosia Wednesday 27 – Thursday 28</p> <p>Quilt measures 86” x 86”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The much loved eight-pointed Le Moyne star is the stunning main focus of this traditional style quilt and is constructed from a variety of fabrics, 9 in total. Fabrics can be bold, contemporary, reproduction or simply fun! • In this class we will cover colour placement to create a stunning, very large star; Quilt construction and precision piecing. • Pattern is included in the class fee; an Acrylic set of templates is required at an additional cost of \$10 (payable on the day)
